The bank has set a target for its own net direct emissions to be zero by 2030. By 2030, the bank also aims to significantly increase the share of sustainable lending. As society's requirements and sustainability goals for 2030/2050 evolve, the bank will further specify its targets and develop measures to achieve them.</p> <p>We place a special focus on the UN Sustainable Development Goals 8,11,12,13 and 17.</p>	<p>We are committed to working closely with our clients to support sustainable practices, enable inclusive economic development.
